Air & Space (ages 9–11 wk 7) — Let your imagination take flight as we join Sir Isaac Newton and prepare for aerospace adventures with his laws of motion. Follow the history of flight from early balloon flights through modern rocketry. Design, build, and test fantastic flying creations. Experiment with the laws of physics, gravity and motion during this amazing week of hands-on fun.

America the Beautiful (ages 4–5, wk 3) – Do you love the USA? If so, then this is the perfect camp for you! Spend the week of the 4th of July discovering just what makes our country so great through games, crafts activities and more.

American Girl® (ages 6-8, wks 5 & 7) – Enjoy a week full of American Girl® parties, games and activities. Learn what it means to be a girl of strong character – confident and loyal, courageous and kind.

ARTpourri (ages 9-11, wk 3 / ages 6-8 wk 7) – Art comes alive in this potpourri of hands-on exploration of creative art. Express yourself through the creation of art using different mediums like painting, sketching with charcoal, sculpting, etc

Artsy Craftsy (ages 6-8, wk 4) – Let's get crafty! In this DIY craft class campers will engage in a wide variety of age-stimulating arts and crafts activities and projects. This camp is sure to get your creative juices flowing!

Baking (ages 9–11, wk 2 / ages 10–13 wk 7) — Learn the art of baking through instruction and hands—on practice. Bake, decorate, and taste your very own cookies, cakes, pies, and pastries. *There is a \$30/student surcharge for this class to cover materials.*

Basketball (ages 6-8, wk 5) – Learn the basic skills of ball handling, passing, shooting and defense through drills, competitions and scrimmages, as well as good sportsmanship, all in a fun, supportive environment.

Boys Being Boys (ages 6–8, wk 3) – Spend an adventure-filled week with just the boys! Learn how to escape quicksand, build a raft, start a survival fire, tie basic knots, place a splint or write with invisible ink. Even learn some basic etiquette so you can impress like James Bond.

Camping 101 (ages 6-8, wk 2) – Learn basic camping skills like building fires and pitching tents. Make camping food such as s'mores and trail mix. Build your own lantern. Learn to identify different animal tracks. Sing campfire songs, roast marshmallows, go on a nature-themed scavenger hunt and tell scary stories.

Christmas in July (ages 6-8, wk 5 / ages 9-11 wk 6) — Reignite the spirit of Christmas during the summer months with music, crafts, and other fun winter wonderland activities sure to get you to forget what season it really is.

Crazy Games (ages 6-8, wks 1 & 4) – The week is all about fun and unusual games. Campers will learn some unique games – like Gagaball, Jugball, Ants on a Log, Pin Down, Keeper of the Castle, 9 Square in the Air – how to think outside of the box, and how to create their own games!

Duct Tape Fabrication (ages 9-11, wk 4) – Have you ever wanted to just get your hands on lots of colorful duct tape, some cardboard and other odds and ends to create something? If so, this class is for you! Build free form or follow plans to build things like flip flops, a Captain America Shield, Thor's hammer, a backpack, wallet and other cool things!

Fashion Design (ages 6–8, wks 1 & 3) — Put your designing caps on to make fun and funky clothes out of unique new and recycled materials that will rival the ones of the red carpet.

Food Art (ages 9–11, wk 4) — Enjoy cupcake decorating, candy mosaics, mini foods and more, merge your artistic and culinary talents into something delicious! There is a \$30/student surcharge for this class to cover materials.

Fun Factory (ages 6-8, wk 4 / ages 9-11, wk 5) — Come spend a week in our fun factory! Test the limits of fun; making things like play doh, paint, chalk, bubbles, glow-in-the-dark slime, tie dye, and more!

Girl Power (ages 6-8, wk 3) – Whether you're a tomboy, a girly-girl, or a little bit of both, we invite you to join us for a summer adventure where we'll explore the gift and strength of your feminine genius! Learn about female heroes in history, female Nobel Prize winners, and female Saints; basic self-defense and how to deal with bullies; how to throw a football and even how to negotiate. Enjoy dance parties, making friendship bracelets, a tea party, and more!

Grab Bag Sports (ages 9-11, wks 2 & 7 / ages 6-8 wk 6) – Do you love all sports? Then this is the camp for you! Play a new sport every day, anything from baseball to soccer to ultimate frisbee. Get a chance to learn the basics, run drills, play skill games, and scrimmage for 5 different sports! Go team!

Gross & Fun Science (ages 6-8, wk 2 / ages 9-11 wk 7) — Ponder, predict and play your way through a week of slimy hands-on experiments designed to encourage curiosity and wonder. All experiments will be either gross, or fun, but ideally both!

Hair & Nail Salon (ages 6-8, wk 6) – Have fun exploring hair and nail care and design! Girls will paint and decorate nails, enjoy manicure and pedicure workshops, and learn and practice various hair wrapping and braiding methods.

Ice Cream Shoppe (ages 9–11, wk 3 / ages 10–13, wk 5) — Do you like homemade ice cream? Spend a week creating your own flavors of ice cream, working in teams as you name your shoppe, create your logo and go into business making ice cream. Take home daily samples of your special custom flavors and toppings. *There is a \$30/student surcharge for this class to cover materials.*

Jr. Engineering (ages 10-13, wk 4 / ages 9-11, wk 5) — Discover how things move with science. Join a team of Jr. Engineers and build bridges, domes, cubes and pyramids. Assemble simple machines such as, levers, pulleys, catapults, balances, crank fans, and/or tops to investigate the laws of physics.

Jr. Olympics (ages 4-5, wk 1) – Come learn about different sports such as basketball, track and field, soccer, kickball, tee-ball, lacrosse, tag and playing catch with a lightweight ball. At the end of the week you'll put your skills to the test in a fun Olympic-style competition.

Laser Tag (ages 9-11, wk 4 / ages 10-13 wk 6) — Spend a week learning team strategies and playing one of the most popular games in the galaxy!

LEGO® (ages 6-8, wks 4 & 7) – Could you spend all day building new LEGO® creations? Do you think your LEGO® building skills could win a competition? Then you've come to the right place! Join your fellow campers in learning how to make different LEGO® builds like cars and wrecking balls, with plenty of free building time to let the creative juices flow!

Magic & Illusions (ages 9–11, wk 5) — Everyone can be a magician! Try your hand at palming cards, master the art of illusion and misdirection, and perfect your stage presence. Campers are provided materials and props but are welcome to bring their own supplies! On the last day of camp, campers become star performers in a magic show for parents and relatives.

Mario Madness (ages 6-8, wk 1) – Activate your star power and join Mario on his adventure through the Mushroom Kingdom and beyond. Get ready to flash through this camp through imaginative play, storytelling, creative movement, and arts&crafts.

Marvel Universe (ages 6-8, wk 2) – Explore the creation & history of Marvel and their most popular superheroes like Spider-Man, Iron Man, Captain America and Wolverine. Become your favorite Marvel character for a week, write a comic, train your superpowers with super stunts and test yourself in a supercharged obstacle course. Unleash your inner superhero for a week of fun in the Marvel Universe!

May the Force Be with You (ages 6–8, wk 5) — Join the Resistance! Begin your Jedi training and explore new galaxies as you fight for peace and justice. Learn the ways of the Force, build droids, go on Jedi missions, eat Star Wars food and play Jedi games. Are you ready to help Rey, Finn, Poe, Chewbacca, Luke Skywalker and Princess Leia fight the forces of evil to defeat Kylo Ren and the First Order?

Minecraft (ages 9-11, wk 2 / ages 6-8, wk 6) —Put your creativity caps on to design and build a Minecraft world like never before. Get ready to freely interact with your environment and gather resources needed to create tools, homes, boats, bridges and more.

Mini Weapons of Micro Destruction (ages 10-13, wk 1) - Love combining random objects into catapults, crossbows, and other projectiles? Come learn the basics of medieval warfare through the use of normal household and office supplies while making things like a pen blowgun, a tiny trebuchet, slingshots, a paper dart watch, targets, and more. Strict safety measures will be observed in the camp. Safe destruction is our motto!

Nerf Wars (ages 10–13 wk 2 / ages 9–11, wks 3 & 6) – Nerf week is loaded with fun! You will create battlefields, hone your targeting skills, learn tactical movements, and engage in team building games through a variety of different styles of nerf war play.

Once Upon A Time (ages 4-5, wk 5) – Make cool crafts, stretch your imagination and creativity, and play fun games as you journey through classic fairy tales! Dance with Cinderella or run around with the Three Little Pigs as we rediscover these beautiful stories in new ways.

Pies A Plenty (ages 9–11, wk 1) — Become a master pie maker as you create both sweet pies and pizza pies over the course of the week, taste testing different recipes and hopefully taking leftovers home! You will learn about making pastry, making dough, double crust pies, deep dish vs NY style, lattice top pies, fruit fillings, and more! *There is a* \$30/student surcharge for this class to cover materials.

Pizza Shoppe (ages 9–11, wk 6) — Become the owner of your very own pizza shoppe. Work alongside other campers to create a shoppe name and logo while working daily to create the perfect sauce and trying out different types of crust. There is a \$30/student surcharge for this class to cover materials.

Pokémon Adventure (ages 6-8, wk 3) - Wanna catch 'em all? Come join Ash and Pikachu on a Pokémon journey to see if you have what it takes to become a true Pokémon Master. Learn about the different types of Pokémon, design your own Pokéball, build your team, and battle it out in the gyms all while eating Pokémon snacks and learning to become the best trainer in the region. Can you beat the Elite Four and become the champion? Come find out!

Princesses & Knights (ages 4–5, wk 1) – Spend a week as royalty as a princess or knight. Explore an ancient world through exciting activities, games, music, and art projects.

Safari Adventure (ages 4-5 wk 7) – An exciting week filled with discovery! Campers will role play going on a safari and become experts on safari animals and their habitat. A week filled with lots of safari games, activities, and arts and crafts.

Sculpting (ages 6-8, wk 1) – Are you the next Donatello or Michelangelo? Spend a week honing your sculpting skills. View examples from some of the greatest artists in history and try your hand at sculpting using a variety of materials such as clay, soap and similar medium.

Spa Science (ages 6–8, wk 2) – Mix it, measure it, make it, try it out and take it home! You will get busy making fizzy bath bombs, sweet lip smackers, shake 'em up bath salts, yummy face masks and more. Become a clever spa scientist for the week as you learn about ingredients and how to combine them to make fun (and fabulous!) pampering goodies. Friday will be "Spa Day," where everyone can dress in a robe and slippers and sample and share what's been made! You will go home with new science know-how, spa goodies, and recipe cards detailing how to make what you created for the week. This hands-on class will make science "real" — and fun!

Spies & Detectives (ages 9–11, wk 1/ ages 6–8 wk 6) — Learn secrets of espionage and detective work; from dissolving messages and decoding clues, students will have the opportunity to check out the skills that spies and detectives have in this hands-on journey into the world of espionage and detective work.

Stars and Seas (ages 4–5, wk 2) – From the depths of the oceans to the limits of the galaxy, explore it all in a single week! Do you like sharks, dolphins and the occasional octopus? What about space travel and rocket ships? Join us for a week of activities and games that will engage you in the wonders of the stars and the seas!

Superheroes (ages 4–5, wk 6) – A whole week of superheroes! Create your own superhero, superpowers, and back story. Train to use your superpowers with super stunts and test yourself in a supercharged obstacle course. Design your own logos and costumes, take on special missions, tackle obstacle courses and go on rescue missions to save other superheroes from villains.

Survival Training (ages 9-11, wk 1) – Are you the next Bear Grylls or Les Stroud? Join us for an exciting week learning many valuable skills, like tying important knots, starting a fire without matches or a lighter, building a sleeping shelter, making snares, developing directional skills and much more!

Tennis & Pickleball (ages 10–13, wk 3) — Allow us to introduce you to the games of tennis and pickleball! Tennis is a classic sport that anyone can learn, and pickleball is a trendy new game that is sweeping the nation! Learn the rules of each game and ball and racquet control while playing fun skill games and drills, before scrimmaging with your fellow campmates. All skill levels welcome, equipment will be provided but campers are welcome to bring their own.

Treasure Hunt (ages 6–8 wk 7) – Do you love challenges? If so, this is the camp for you! Search for hidden treasure using treasure maps, while competing with other crews searching for the same treasure. Learn the history of famous pirates and treasures and how maps were coded. Get competitive with your team in a series of timed scavenger hunts, and even create your own hunt to send your campmates on!
